Now Accepting Glass for Recycling

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ):

What kind of glass do we take?

Short Answer: All food and beverage glass is fine.
You keep the lids and corks.

Can I put window glass in the bin?

No windows or windshields.

Do I have to rinse the containers?

That would be nice. But it's not essential.

You may, however, decide rinsing the containers keeps your home or garage smelling a bit fresher.

Do I have to separate glass by color?

No you don't! All brown, green, blue, and clear food and beverage containers can be mixed together in the same collection bin for glass only.

Do I need to take the labels off?

Nope. You can leave all the labels on your containers.

What about Pyrex or old coffee mugs?

We cannot accept mirrors, windows, Pyrex, Corning Ware, ceramics, dishes, windshields or ham sandwiches. We can accept all glass food and beverage containers, of any color (including mason jars).

Can I bring glass to recycle center in plastic bags?

For the safety of our volunteers, absolutely no glass can be accepted in plastic bags due to hazards associated with broken glass. We suggest you bring glass in plastic wastebaskets, bins, buckets or reusable cardboard boxes. Thanks for your cooperation on this important safety requirement.

What happens to the glass I recycle? Some is made into fiberglass insulation for energy conservation, and some of it is made into more bottles. It all depends on the color.
